Invitation

The Relais Ski Center Lac Beauport and the Organizing Committee (OC) are pleased to invite all eligible freestyle skiers, coaches to attend the 2022 Canadian Aerial Championship series presented by Toyota to be held at Lac Beauport, Quebec, Canada on March 5 to 6, 2022.

The Competition is comprised of one (1) Aerial event for Junior and one (1) Aerial event for Senior.

*Vaccination

Health Canada, the federal and provincial governments, the Public Health Agency of Canada, regional public health authorities, the Canadian Medical Association have all endorsed voluntary COVID-19 Vaccination for all adults who may safely receive a Vaccine.

FC requires that all Participants who are eligible and not exempt for medical or religious reasons, be Vaccinated at least 14-days prior to engaging in FC Activities or entering FC Premises. Participants must provide proof of Vaccination prior to entering FC Premises or participating in FC Activities.

Participants who are not Vaccinated or do not provide adequate Proof of Vaccination may be barred from entry or use of FC Premises and participation in FC Activities.

General Information

Date and Location

Aerials (AE) competitions and training will be in course no 8C.















Rules

Freestyle Canada is sanctioning this Competition for the Junior and FIS for the Senior event. The Organizing Committee of the event will host the competition in accordance with the Canada Cup Guidelines and the FIS rules.

Quota & Format for JUNIOR event:

Filed size: 80-100

Aerials: 25 spots are to be saved for the Aerial specialist athletes Format: Sum of best two jumps out of 3, can repeat one jump.

Venue: Single kicker, mogul jump, hybrid jump

Eligibility:

Age categories *:

U14 (12 & 13) - (2008-2009)

U16 (14 & 15) - (2007-2006)

U18 (16 & 17) - (2005- 2004)

Age categories can be merged if needed and exceptions can be requested considering they meet quota criteria and minimum skill level.

Quota & Format for SENIOR event:

Filed size: no field size or quota restrictions NorAm format: best of two jumps, final Top 6

Eligibility: no eligibility criteria.

Entries

All athletes entered in the Canadian Sr Championship must hold a valid FIS License issued under the authority of their national ski association and conform to the rules in the FIS ICR Sections 203 and 204. All athletes entered in the Canadian Jr Championship must hold a minimum of a Provincial athlete's license with Freestyle Canada according to the Canada Cup Guidelines.
