



Job Description for Panorama Freestyle Team Assistant Head Coach (Part of PMFC)

Panorama Freestyle Team's Mission: To engage, develop and promote athletes to a provincial and national level in a fun, safe and positive atmosphere.

Reports to: Head Coach.

Location: Panorama Mountain, BC, Canada.

Salary: Based on experience.

Qualifications: Supercoach Qualified with Air 4 or the ability to achieve this level.

Experience: The candidate must show an understanding of both Slopestyle and Mogul competitions and have experience in attending freestyle events.

Working commitments

Saturday and Sunday (on snow delivery and coach/ group management). Possible travel to away competitions.

Roles and Responsibilities with competition and freestyle team may include

- Assisting Head Coach to manage the seasons training and competition budget and insure all costs come within remit
- Assisting Head Coach to organize additional training and development opportunities for athletes
- Assisting Head Coach to organize summer training opportunity's
- Assisting Head Coach to liaise with competition organizers to ensure all requirements for the team are met including licencing and registration. This includes coach licencing
- Assisting Head Coach to ensure that athletes are suitably prepared for any competition
- Ensuring that all facility's, home or away are suitable for the athlete's performance, especially in cases where inverts are carried out
- Ensure the highest level of safety is maintained
- Assisting Head Coach to build and maintain the Moguls course at Panorama
- Assisting Head Coach to produce high level LTAD's for competitive athletes on an annual basis
- Follow LTAD's
- Travel to away competitions (for up to 1 week)

Possible additional requirements

- Travel to Junior or Senior Nationals where require
- Travel to any additional competitions where needed
- Travel to Calgary for additional training at COP

Roles and responsibilities with coaches and training



- Be the public face of PMFC and represent the team and brand that is Panorama Mountain Freeride Club and the Panorama Mountain Freestyle Team in a professional and respectful manner.
- Demonstrate commitment by attending all required training, safety and meetings
- Provide quality instruction to groups and individuals by ensuring we are providing a safe, positive and engaging atmosphere in which to learn.
- Create a fun environment and lesson plans with coaches that are motivating and conducive to learning.
- Encourage athlete enthusiasm for the learning process and continued development. - Follow PMFC code of conduct while acting as a role model for young athletes - Attending morning meetings before training.
- Help manage coach time keeping and ensure training starts in a prompt manner each day.
- Help manage any athlete or parent concerns with training and/or coaches
- Help manage any coach illness or unavailability and insure correct cover is available.
- Help manage any coach complaints or problems and escalate if necessary.
- Help manage group levels and ability's and alter as necessary.
- Help manage any emergency or medical situations quickly and efficiently.
- Attend pre-season coach's meetings
- Insure safe working practices are followed by all coaches always.
- Help build and strengthen the current program where needed.
- Support the Program Director where needed.
