You don't have to ski to volunteer but it does help. A limited number of volunteer lift tickets will be available to those who sign up. Volunteers are required to have an associate membership with Freestyle Canada (https://freestylebc.ski/register/) to be protected under the Freestyle Canada liability policy for sanctioned events. Associate members will be provided with free access to the Snowsports Officials online education program (https://www.snowsportsofficials.com/en/). Thank you! We expect all coaches to assist with all course prep and maintenance.

LIFT TICKETS AT APEX MOUNTAIN RESORT

Apex Mountain Resort offers reduced ticket prices to athletes. To purchase tickets:

- Athletes must purchase tickets at resort ticket booth
- Registered athletes will receive a 25% discount for lift pass or the respective reciprocal season pass discounts to their home mountain (proof of pass will be required).
- Athletes must show/wear their bib for discount
- MC/Visa accepted
- Ticket office opens at 8am daily

Complimentary lift tickets for coaching staff, judges, officials and volunteers are available at the Race Office each day.

COMPETITION OFFICE: The competition office will be located in the Brown Bag lunchroom on the lower level of the Gunbarrel building.

ENTRY AND REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- All athletes must register and make payment online before January 15th
- Athletes must be represented by a certified Freestyle Canada coach.

- Registration fees are to be paid online.
- Timber Tour Bibs All Timber Tour athletes will purchase a bib for use at all 2019 Timber Tour events. The cost for the bibs will be \$30.00 and will be paid during the online registration.
- Super Youth Bibs: Will be assigned a bib for the duration of the event and be required to pay a \$20 bib deposit. The bib deposit must be paid in cash. Please note, there is only one cash machine at the resort and it can be unreliable at times. Bib deposit will be returned at end of the competition on Sunday immediately after the last run.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Timber Tour athletes require a minimum of a CanFree 3 membership with Freestyle Canada.
- Super Youth athletes require a minimum of a CanFree 1&2 membership with Freestyle Canada.
- Coaches, judges and officials must have an active membership with Freestyle Canada to meet the sanctioning requirements for the Freestyle Canada liability insurance: https://freestylebc.ski/register/

REGISTRATION COST

- \$160 (Duals and moguls) for Youth, Juvenile, Junior and Senior Timber Tour Competitors.
- \$95 (slopestyle, big air and moguls) for Super Youth Competitors.
- If space is available athletes may be permitted to register late and will be charged an additional \$35 fee.

TIMBER TOUR BIB PURCHASE

- \$30 per athlete
- Athletes must wear bib during training and competition. Athletes not wearing appropriate bib may be disqualified.
- An athlete will be assigned a bib for use at all 2019 Timber Tour events.

SUPER YOUTH BIB DEPOSIT

- \$20 per athlete
- Athletes must wear bib during training and competition. Athletes not wearing appropriate bib may be disqualified.
- The \$20 deposit will be refunded upon return of the athlete's bib. Bibs must be returned clean and undamaged.
- Please note, there is only one cash machine at the resort and it can be unreliable at times.

BASIC EVENT PROGRAM - TIMBER TOUR

The event is comprised of Single Moguls and Dual Moguls for Youth, Juvenile, Junior and Senior Competitors.

BASIC EVENT PROGRAM - SUPER YOUTH

A Super Youth event will be judged separately with a separate schedule that includes: Single Moguls, Slopestyle and Big Air.

Athletes will access all courses from the T-bar. Athletes must ride T-bar to the top (do not eject early). Athletes who unload early risk losing lift privilege.

Event schedule is posted at the competition office and any changes to the schedule will be posted daily. Spectators and media are encouraged to watch these young athletes. Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of each competition.

STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Apex Freestyle Club (organizing committee), Apex Mountain Resort, Freestyle Canada, Freestyle BC, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

REFUND POLICY, as per TT Guidelines

If a competition is cancelled, \$30CDN shall be refunded to each athlete registered for that event. An athlete shall receive a maximum refund of \$30CDN per competition event if he/she is registered in more than one event that is cancelled. If an event is rescheduled at another venue, \$30CDN will be charged to the participating athletes.

Injury Refund Policy: A registered athlete who withdraws from an event *before the generation of the start list* will receive a refund of 50% of their entry fee. Athletes that appear on the official start list for an event will not be given a refund. No refunds will be given without a written request received no later than 7 days after the completion of the last event day.
