This event is a 2 day, slopestyle event. Each day is a separate competition.

The idea is to provide more training time and exposure to slopestyle event skiing, and most importantly, have fun!

The slopestyle event will consist of a best of, two run format each day.

The Jury will retain the right to change the format depending on weather conditions and time restraints.
