## **Competition Rules**

- 1. This competition is sanctioned by Freestyle BC.
- 2. This competition is being organized by Freestyle Panorama Ski Club & Panorama Mountain Resort.
- 3. The competition will be held under FBC rules and regulations for Freestyle Skiing.
- 4. All competitors must possess a Freestyle Canada Competitor license valid in British Columbia. Athletes require a Provincial Athlete License at minimum. Membership can be renewed online: <a href="https://www.freestylebc.ski/join/">www.freestylebc.ski/join/</a>
- 5. Please ensure your athletes are registered before online registration closes. All Athletes are expected to complete the Bio form included in their online registration.
- 6. Athlete bibs must be worn during all official training and competition. No exceptions.
- 7. All competitors must follow the COVID guidelines set forth by local, provincial and federal governments, sport governing bodies, and Freestyle Panorama Ski Club's Timber Tour Communicable Diseases Plan. This includes (but is not limited to) viaSport, BC Government, Freestyle BC, and Panorama Mountain Resort: FPSC TT Event Plan

Late entries will be subject to a \$30 late registration fee.

Competitors will be registered on a first come, first served basis.

Event will consist of 3 disciplines – Moguls, Big Air, and Slopestyle.

## **Entry Fees**

TT Invite: January 13 - 16, 2022

#### **Timber Tour**

- \$180 includes moguls, slopestyle, and big air events.
- \$30 Timber Tour bib fee. Athletes will keep this bib for the duration of the season. The fee is non-refundable.
- Entry and bib fees are paid online.

#### **Super Youth**

- \$95 includes slopestyle, big air, and mogul events.
- \$20 Super Youth bib deposit. Bib deposit must be paid in cash and will be refunded upon return at the completion of the event. Bib deposit will be collected by cash payment at the competition office.

## **Refund Policy**

**Cancellation of event:** If the entire event is cancelled due to COVID, <u>full entry fee</u> shall be refunded to each athlete registered for the event. If the event is rescheduled at another venue, \$30CDN will be charged to participating athletes.

**Injury/COVID Refund Policy:** A registered athlete who withdraws from an event before the generation of the start list will receive a full refund. Athletes that appear on the official start list for an event will not be eligible for a refund.

## **Team Check-in**

For team check-in, the race office will be located at the Copper Crown (Appendix B) and is to be <u>accessed by Coaches only</u>. Coaches are asked to check in as early as possible to:

- Confirm athlete information (e.g. name, age, events)
- Pick up athlete bibs. \*Please be prepared with cash for the SY bib deposit of \$20/bib
- Hand in waiver forms.

### **Liability and Accident Insurance**

- All competitors 19 years of age or older will be required to sign a waiver at the time of registration on Snowreg. All competitors under the age of 19 must have a team leader, parent or guardian authorized to sign a waiver.
- All athletes, officials and other team members who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk.
- Volunteers, coaches and officials must be members of Freestyle Canada. Register online at www.freestylebc.ski/join/.

## **Lift Tickets**

Competition day lift tickets are available at Guest Services in the Ski Tip Lodge.

All competitors, staff and volunteers must carry an RFID electronic lift ticket and complete an event waiver prior to accessing the mountain or chairlifts. Please note that the rates below do not include taxes nor the \$5 deposit for the card.

# **Getting to Panorama**

#### By Car

Panorama is situated in BC's Purcell Mountains. The nearest major city is Calgary, AB, just a 3-hour drive away.

Access from Calgary is west, via Highway 1 through the Banff and Kootenay National Parks, followed by a turn south on Highway 93 through to Radium and onwards to Invermere, BC.

From Invermere, a gentle 20 minute drive rises into the Purcell Mountains and winds towards Panorama Mountain Resort. <a href="Open Google Map & Directions">Open Google Map & Directions</a>

#### By Air

- 1. The Calgary International Airport (YYC) is the most common access point to Panorama. From Calgary you'll enjoy a scenic 311 km drive through the world-famous Banff and Kootenay National Parks. A Parks' Pass is not required to travel *through* the parks, however, if you plan on stopping please purchase a pass at either the Park gate located just west of Canmore or any Parks Canada office.
- 2. The Canadian Rockies International Airport is located 161 km from Panorama in the East Kootenay region (just outside of Cranbrook) of British Columbia. There are currently 10 flights per day with their three Airline partners: WestJet, Air Canada and Pacific Coastal. You can fly directly to/from Calgary and Vancouver.
