



# Lead Slopestyle Coach

Want to be part of a highly skilled, fun, energetic Freestyle club in the unparalleled Kootenay mountains? Look no further! Freestyle Panorama Ski Club (FPSC) is looking for a **Lead Slopestyle Coach** to work closely with our Head Coach and Lead Moguls Coach to expand our dynamic program.

At FPSC we pride ourselves on offering a program that meets the needs of athletes at all levels while accommodating the schedules of busy families. Our 90+ athletes participate in 7-, 14- or 28-day programming and range in ages from 6 to 18. We work closely with Panorama Mountain Resort to design a slopestyle course that offers athletes the opportunity to train single flip inverts, all way spins, rails, tubes, boxes and big air.

As Lead Slopestyle Coach, you will be responsible for working with lead coaches develop and execute training programs for all our athletes. This includes our youngest little rippers right up to our most elite and highly competitive athletes training for podium positions at the Canada Cup. While the focus of this position is on-snow training of athletes, you will also be required to participate in planning meetings, report on weekly progress of athletes, and mentor other slope coaches.

Our ski season runs from November to April with additional training outside of the snow season. Time commitment for regular season training is approximately 8:30 am to 4 pm Saturdays and Sundays with additional days for competitions. As Lead Slopestyle Coach you will also be responsible for some program administration (i.e., lesson planning, athlete and coach evaluations, meeting preparation, competition planning etc.). You may also be eligible for additional coaching opportunities such as mid-week/dryland training: on-snow, trampoline, water ramp, airbag, etc.

## Responsibilities include:

- Providing on-snow slopestyle coaching to athletes.
- Mentoring coaches.
- Working with the Head Coach to support our highest-level slopestyle athletes for the entire year; including off-season / dryland training and competition opportunities.
- Provide input on FPSC club programming and training venues.
- Supporting athletes at competitions across BC and Canada.

## The ideal Lead Slopestyle Coach candidate will have:

- Air 4 (or working to complete Air 4 for the 2022/23 season).
- Completion of "Making Headway" and "Making Ethical Decisions".
- A recent Vulnerable Sector check covering the past 5 years.
- Considerable knowledge of slopestyle competitions, judging and training.
- A proven ability to coach rails and jumps including all 4 ways of spinning in all single flip axes.
- A talent for communicating well with athletes, parents, coaches, and board members.

Compensation is dependent upon experience and qualifications.
