Competition and Registration

Competition Office – National Altitude Training Center

Please head to the Competition office at the NATC when you arrive Wednesday evening or Thursday morning to pick up your athlete packages and purchase your discounted lift tickets. If you will not be at SilverStar by Thursday at noon please have your coach pick up your athlete package for you.

- Wednesday evening from 4 pm to 8:00 pm
- Thursday 7:30 am to noon
- Sunday, noon to 4 pm (SY bib and volunteer radio return)

Rules

1. This competition is sanctioned by Freestyle BC.
2. This competition is being organized by Silverstar Freestyle with support from SilverStar Mountain Resort.
3. The competition will be held under FBC rules and regulations for Freestyle Skiing.
4. All competitors must possess a Freestyle Canada Competitor license valid in British Columbia. Athletes require a Provincial Athlete license at minimum. [Renew your Freestyle Canada membership online](#). Please ensure your athletes are registered before they arrive.
5. Athlete bibs must be worn during all official training and competition. No exceptions - hanging the bib outside of the pocket does not qualify as wearing your bib; it must be worn in the traditional fashion.

Athlete Registration

- Registration for the **Timber Tour** will be capped at 100 athletes for all disciplines - Moguls, Dual Moguls, Slopestyle and Big Air.
- Registration for **Super Youth** will also be capped at 100 athletes for all disciplines - Moguls, Slopestyle and Big Air.
- Competitors will be registered on a first-come, first-served basis.



Entry Fees

Entry fees are paid online via SnowReg.

Timber Tour:

- \$215 - Includes Slopestyle, Big Air, Moguls and Dual Moguls
 - \$45 Timber Tour bib fee IF NOT RETURNED at the end of the event
- *no bib deposits are collected

Super Youth:

- \$95 - Includes Festival Events, Slopestyle, Moguls and Big Air
 - \$20 Super Youth bib fee IF NOT RETURNED at the end of the event
- *no bib deposits are collected

Bibs will be included in your athlete package and can be picked up on Wednesday or Thursday at the comp office.

At the end of the events, all athletes/ parents are asked to return their bib(s) either to the volunteer at the bottom of the Big Air event OR to the comp office to avoid being charged the 'Bib-fee' noted above.

Lift Tickets

Thank you very much to SilverStar Mountain Resort for offering 50% discounted lift ticket prices for athletes. Teams with less than 9 athletes will receive one complimentary coach pass. Teams with 9 or more athletes will receive 2 complimentary coach passes. Head Coaches will be sent a Google form to fill out with coach information that must be completed prior to March 27th.
