Competition and Registration




Figure 1: Venue Locations

The Competition Office will be located in the Copper Crown Reception Room (Figure 1).

Athletes need to check in prior to training to pick up bibs and confirm registration information (note: bibs *must* be worn during training, inspection, etc.). The office will be open for registration and payment:

Wednesday evening: 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm

Thursday/Friday/Saturday/Sunday: 7:00 am - 6:00 pm

Competition Rules

- 1. This competition is sanctioned by Freestyle BC.
- 2. This competition is being organized by Freestyle Panorama Ski Club with support from Panorama Mountain Resort.
- 3. The competition will be held under FBC rules and regulations for Freestyle Skiing.
- 4. Athlete bibs must be worn during all training and competition. No exceptions hanging the bib outside of the pocket does not qualify as wearing your bib; it must be worn in the traditional fashion.
- 5. All competitors must possess a Freestyle Canada Competitor license valid in British Columbia. At minimum, Timber Tour athletes require a Provincial Athlete License, and Super Youth athletes require a Club Athlete License. Membership can be renewed online: www.freestylebc.ski/join/ Please ensure your athletes are licensed before they arrive.

Competitors will be registered on a first come, first served basis. The TT event is capped at 90 athletes and SY event capped at 85 athletes.



Entry Fees

Timber Tour

- \$215 includes moguls, dual moguls, slopestyle, and big air events.
- \$45 Timber Tour bib fee. Athletes will keep this bib for the duration of the season. The fee is non-refundable.
- Entry and bib fees are paid online.

Super Youth

- \$95 includes Slopestyle, Moguls and Panorama's very own Mountain Skills Challenge.
- \$20 Super Youth bib fee Athlete bibs must be returned at the end of the event. Any bibs NOT RETURNED, will result in a mandatory \$20 charge being added to that athletes' SnowReg account.

Refund Policy

Refunds may be provided up to 72 hours before the first Team Leaders' meeting as per below.

Event Cancellation:

If an event is cancelled due to weather or exceptional circumstances no refunds will be provided as the organizing committee will have already incurred the costs for the event.

Refund due to injury:

- 1. A registered athlete who withdraws from the entire event after registration closes and before the generation of the start list will receive a refund of 50% of their entry fee.
- 2. Athletes who appear on the official start list for an event WILL NOT be given a refund.
- 3. No refunds will be given without a written request received no later than 7 days after the completion of the last event day.
- 4. SnowReg transaction fees are fixed and cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
- 5. Refunds will be issued electronically and may take up to 30 days to be processed.
- 6. Refunds will not be issued on-site.
- 7. Requests for refunds for other extraordinary circumstances shall be considered at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

Lift Tickets

Competition day lift tickets are available at Guest Services in the Ski Tip Lodge.



All competitors, staff and on-hill volunteers must carry an RFID electronic lift ticket and complete a PMR waiver prior to accessing the mountain or chairlifts. Volunteers receiving a complementary lift pass from the Competition Office will be required to complete the waiver on-line. Panorama Mountain Resort is pleased to offer discounted lift passes to all competitors at a rate of 25% off of the window price (note: rates do not include taxes or the \$5 RFID card deposit). To obtain your competitor lift passes, please present your race bib to the ticket office at Guest Services. Complimentary coaches' passes will be available at a rate of 1 per 10 athletes for race days only. They will be available for pickup at the Race Office.

Accommodation

PMR will provide a discount on lodging rates for event participants.
